Thursday August 11th will be a free day for the World Championships. We are happy to invite all the World Championships Teams to participate in "Toppidrettsveka" races in Aure that day:

- 10:00 Off Road Race – 35 km bicycling in Aure Valley
- 16:00 1500 m Sprint Rollerski in Aure center – classic style, slow wheels

We are also happy to invite all the teams on a boat trip on Thursday. This will take place in Kristiansund.

It will this year be possible for the teams to stay in Aure. For more details – see the section "Accommodation and Logistics".

The teams get the new Aure sports hall (Aure Arena) available where they can relax and where they get access to showers and toilets.
