Novgorod region is located in the North-West part of Russia, with regional centre Veliky Novgorod: 520 km northwest of Moscow and 180 km south of Saint-Petersburg.

Novgorod is one of the oldest Slavic settlements on the Volkhov River. The place was first noticed by chroniclers in 859. Veliky Novgorod is the birthplace of Russian Statehood. *The oldest city in Russia, the cradle of Russian democracy, the medieval centre of trade and crafts, the leading partner of the Hanseatic League of 12th – 17th cc., the link between medieval Europe and Russia and the borderline between two civilizations. All these are descriptions of Veliky Novgorod.*

Nowadays Veliky Novgorod is an industrial and tourist city.

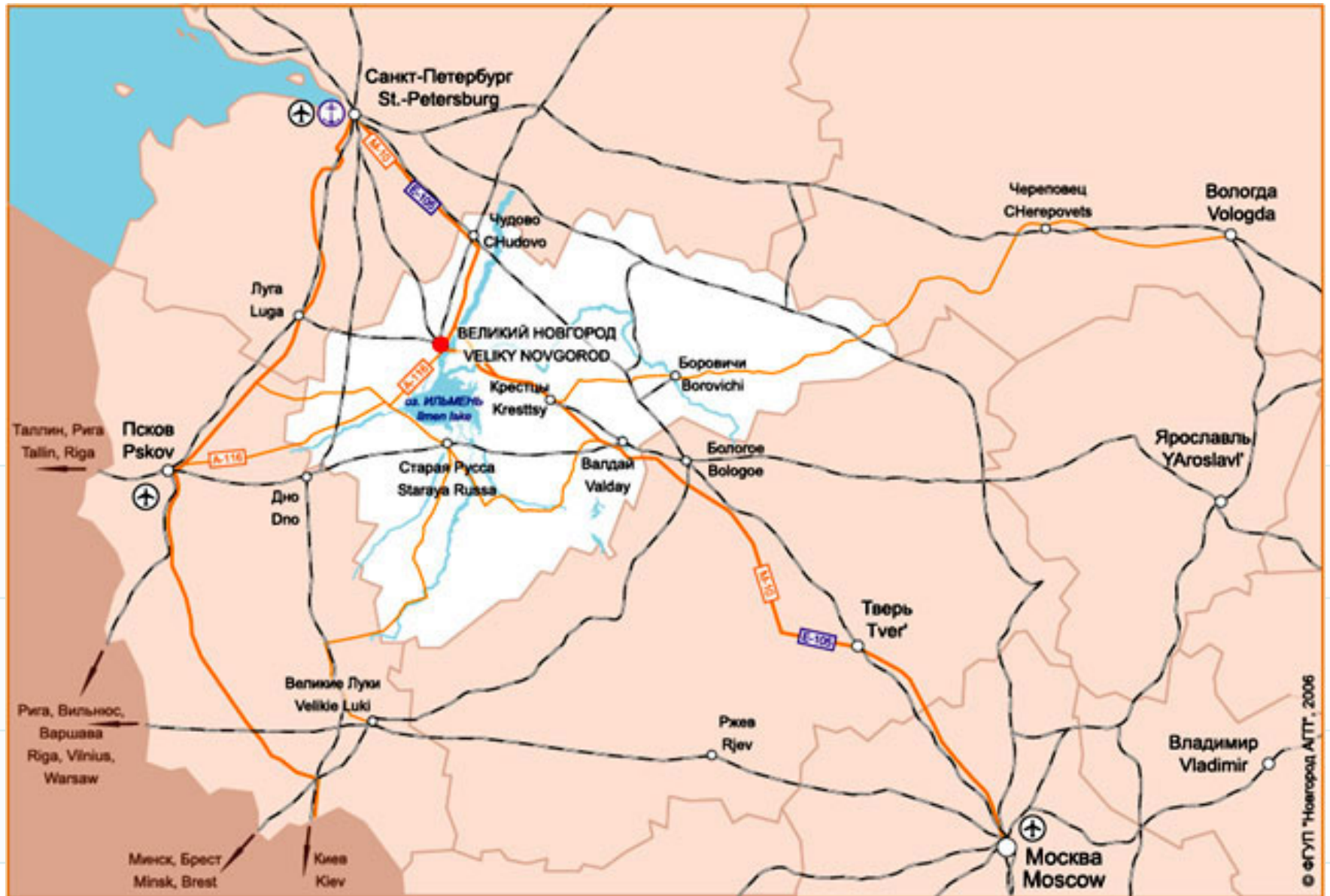

Transfer from the airports to Veliky Novgorod:
From Pulkovo Saint-Petersburg - free of charge by the one bus for all teams together.

From Moscow (SVO):

Bus upto 50 seats – 850 Euro

Minibus for 13 seats – 400 Euro

Minibus for 8 seats – 300 Euro.

Travel time from St.Petersburg– 2-2,5 hours.

Travel time from Sheremetievo (SVO) – 6-7 hours.

Travel time from Domodedovo (DME) – 11 – 12 hours.

Free transport service will be offered during your stay in Novgorod, including pick-up and delivery service from the place of accommodation to the stadium and back.
